(STARSTON) (EMERGENCY NOTICE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2019
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to a burst water main the use by vehicles of the C357 Clintergate Road from its junction with U76052 Church Road for a distance of 20 metres westwards in the PARISH OF STARSTON will be temporarily prohibited from 28th March 2019 to 3rd April 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: Clintergate Road, Hardwick Road, Starston Road, Port Road, Common Road, Low Road, Middle Road, The Street, B1527 Mill Road, Alburgh Road, Spring Lane, Barondole Lane, Broad Road, Mill Road, Clintergate Road (Topcroft/ Hempnall/ Denton/ Morningthorpe and Fritton/ Redenhall with Harleston/ Shelton and Hardwick/ Alburgh/ Starston).

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
